Kyrle Probus Club member Norman Duffield gave a very informative talk about his wide-ranging and challenging career in industry at the Club meeting on Thursday 15 September.



Norman covered many aspects of the industrial world in which he was involved. He spoke of his work in electrical engineering; construction; manufacturing; marketing and management, much of it being in an executive role.

From his early years, both as a trainee draughtsman and a trainee engineer, Norman took on increasingly responsible positions. They included working on major railway electrification as a site

engineer and later as a senior design engineer with a 150-strong workforce, among them designers, technicians and laboratory personnel.

Norman also joined GEC High Voltage Division as Business Development Director responsible for developing global business opportunities. His other projects meant travelling on export business across the world, from Lagos in Nigeria and several visits to the United States, relocating factories and bidding to provide metallic strips for new bank notes.
